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## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

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Although a revolution in the eating habits of Americans has occurred during the past two decades, the Allen Foundation is aware that malnutrition still exists in the United States. In responding to the ills of malnutrition, our foundation has undertaken two major projects. The first is a \$500,000.00 commitment over the next five years to establish a distinguished chair in nutrition in memory of William W. Allen at Texas A&M University at its College Station or Houston campus. This grant will be matched by the Texas A&M Development Foundation.

Our second grant is for \$300,000.00 over a three year period for a dining facility at the new Washington Woods complex in Midland, Michigan. Because meals will consist of a nutritionally balanced diet, we believe that what people eat may determine how healthy they are and how long they live.

We are proud to announce in 1989 our initial funding of an academic research proposal. Our grant went to Professor Pamela Fraker in the Biochemistry Department of Michigan State University for her work on using immunological tests for quick assessments of the degree of malnutrition. Our interest in research in both the academic and private sectors will continue.
