LETTER FROM THE CHAIR

In 2020 the focus of the Allen Foundation and the nation was on the COVID 19 pandemic. Allen trustees responded to the devastating impact of food insecurity by giving \$123,635 to be used for COVID 19 relief. Grants included the Crawford County Community Christian Help Center, Midland County Emergency Food Pantry, Midland Open Door, Michigan Restaurant Lodging Association Educational Foundation, Northwest Food Coalition, Bridge Food Center, Zion Lutheran Church-Gods Helping Hands.

The May meeting of the trustees granted funding for additional feeding programs, education programs and research programs for a total of \$1,520,501. Outstanding projects included the development of The Giving Grove Orchard in Memphis, Tennessee, MidMichigan Health Heart and Vascular Center Teaching Kitchen, Gleaners Community Foodbank and research utilizing genomics for personalized nutrition at The University of Toronto.

In 2020 the trustees recognized trustee Patrick Oriel for his 15 years of distinguished service and Kathy McDonald for her 7 plus years of dedicated service as administrative assistant. Both are wished the best on their retirement.

Deep appreciation is due every individual who makes the work of the Allen Foundation possible. Together, our efforts fulfill the mission of our founder, William W. Allen.

GRANT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Allen Foundation Inc. operates under the laws of the State of Michigan, with offices in Midland. In order to be considered for an Allen Foundation grant, you must be a non-profit organization, and be able to provide us with a copy of your federal Internal Revenue Service certification of 501(c) (3) tax-exempt status. Academic research under an Allen Foundation grant should be conducted under the leadership of a principal investigator who is a full-time regular faculty member with tenure or on tenure track. The foundation does not directly administer the programs which it funds. Recipients are asked to submit yearly progress reports and a financial accounting concerning the expenditures of the foundation grant.

Grants are strictly limited under the terms of the charter to projects that benefit programs for human nutrition in the areas of health, education, training, and research. The foundation requires electronic submission of all unsolicited applications for consideration for possible funding. Please go to: http://www. allenfoundation.org/ and follow the instructions for filing a grant application online. The next deadline for submission of proposals is January 15, 2022. This deadline means that any proposal submitted electronically after January 15, 2022 will be considered for possible funding in 2023. The decisions of the board of trustees will be posted on the foundation's website in June of each year. Because of the number of proposals received and the limited resources of the foundation, applicants should never view possible declinations to fund their proposals or delays in reviewing their proposals as judgments on the actual merits of their proposals.
