LETTER FROM THE CHAIR

The Allen Foundation Trustees applaud the significant expansion of programs nationwide in the area of human nutrition during the almost 50 years of the foundation's existence.

In 2021 the Allen Foundation supported forty outstanding projects. Despite the pandemic, innovative strategies ensured the growth and sustainability of these research, feeding and education programs. Examples included an agricultural program taught and supervised by perma-garden experts that developed nutritious, sustainable gardens planted and tended by local Ugandans, close to home. The six direct feeding programs funded are exemplified by the Rolling Harvest Food Rescue that gathered excess food from farmers and delivered it to those in need. Innovative research projects, such as a grant to Boston Children's Hospital to study iron deficiency in placental gene expression and fetal development, provide methods of alleviating placental deficiencies.

Special recognition is due our long-time president, Dr. Mark Ostahowski, and our treasurer, William Lauderbach. Their outstanding leadership and wise guidance has ensured prudent decision making and funding allocation, maximizing the foundation's ability to support quality projects.

The efforts of each individual Trustee and Staff member in 2021 is deeply appreciated. It is only through their collaborative efforts that the Allen Foundation has been able to further its goal of ensuring adequate nutrition for all citizens.

GRANT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Allen Foundation Inc. operates under the laws of the State of Michigan, with offices in Midland. In order to be considered for an Allen Foundation grant, you must be a non-profit organization, and be able to provide us with a copy of your federal Internal Revenue Service certification of 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status. Academic research under an Allen Foundation grant should be conducted under the leadership of a principal investigator who is a full-time regular faculty member with tenure or on tenure track. The foundation does not directly administer the programs which it funds. Recipients are asked to submit yearly progress reports and a financial accounting concerning the expenditures of the foundation grant.

Grants are strictly limited under the terms of the charter to projects that benefit programs for human nutrition in the areas of health, education, training, and research. The foundation requires electronic submission of all unsolicited applications for consideration for possible funding. Please go to: <http://www.allenfoundation.org/> and follow the instructions for filing a grant application online. The next "deadline" for submission of proposals is January 15, 2023. This deadline means that any proposal submitted electronically on or after January 23, 2023, will be considered for possible funding in 2024. The decisions of the board of trustees will be posted on the foundation's website in June of each year. Because of the number of proposals received and the limited resources of the foundation, applicants should never view possible declinations to fund their proposals or delays in reviewing their proposals as judgments on the actual merits of their proposals.
